**EXPECTATION WITHIN THE CHANGE**

ISAIAH 42

I must remember the original instructions

- a. Change does not change the original instructions
- b. God's will has not changed
- c. Change has come to fulfill the original instructions

JOSHUA 1

WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN CHANGE COMES

When change comes, I need to know what to expect from God

I can expect God to deal with me differently

God will deal with me differently to produce growth

1. When change comes expect God to remain the same

I am supposed to remain the same but deal with my children differently to produce growth

I will not be judged by God by how long I let them stay I will be judged by whether or not I train them to go

a. God's promise did not change, they are still a promise they are just not realized

God wants me to live in the promise and not just have a promise.

In the promise I will not have all these things that I relied on, but I will have the promise

b. God will not fail or forsake me

c. God's standard has not changed

I must not confuse change with a change in standard just a change of methodology

d. God's truth remains true

e. God's instructions have not changed

What God expects from me now is to carry out the instructions

John 15:1-4

When change comes:

2. Expect God to purge me

PURGE means to clean, it means to prune

Sometimes the only way to clean I have to change

EXPECT GOD TO PURGE:

a. Unfruitful character

Now that change has come into my life it is going to expose some things in my character that's not fruitful

b. Expect God to purge Unfruitful things

I will know something is unfruitful it will consume but doesn't produce fruit

c. Expect God to purge unfruitful activities

d. Expect God to purge unfruitful people in this New Work

When change comes the worst thing to do is to beg somebody to stay when they want to go

TAKE AWAY means to take away what was committed or appointed and given to another

If I am not bearing fruit in this NEW WORK God will take ME away and he will put someone there who will bear fruit
