GRACE is the the gift of God.

I am saved from sin and death unto life.

Because of GRACE I'm healed, because of GRACE I'm whole, and because of GRACE I am restored.

To glorify God I must be in position and have the power to manifest God in the earth.

I have a dispensation of GRACE.

Dispensation definition: A divinely ordered period of time or span of time

Within this dispensation, God can give me a dispensation within this dispensation, where I receive the sufficiency of his GRACE for the time that I'm in.

The word for dispensation... our root word dispense comes from that.

A dispensation of GRACE it is when God dispenses His grace, His power for the administration of His will, over a certain period of time, to certain person or people, but it is not forever.

A dispensation of GRACE is when God dispenses His grace so that I might take stewardship over His will. For a certain period of time.

A dispensation of GRACE is when God gives me the power I need for the time I need it to do His will.

Ephesians 3:1-7

Colossians 1

God gives instructions in the context of time, because we're trapped in time on this side.

God's instructions match His will and also match the time of our life.

A calling requires a gift and the authority to exercise it....somebody in the natural has to give you the authority to operate in a calling.
